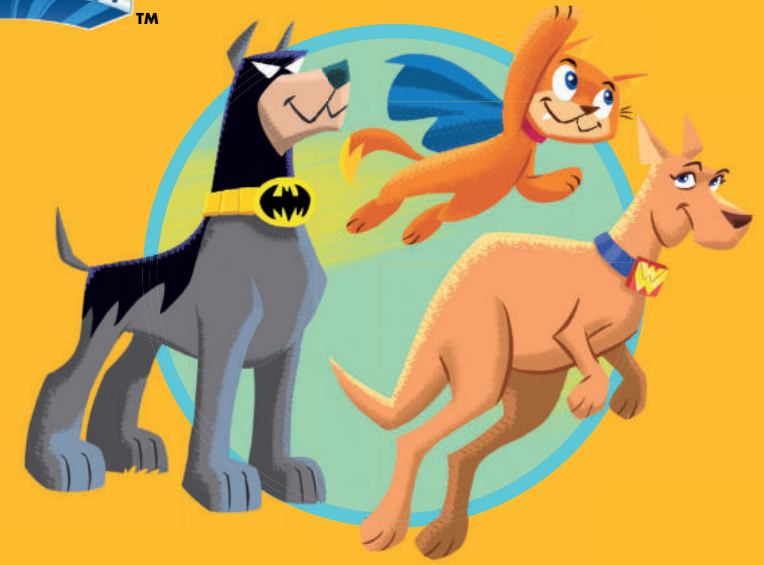

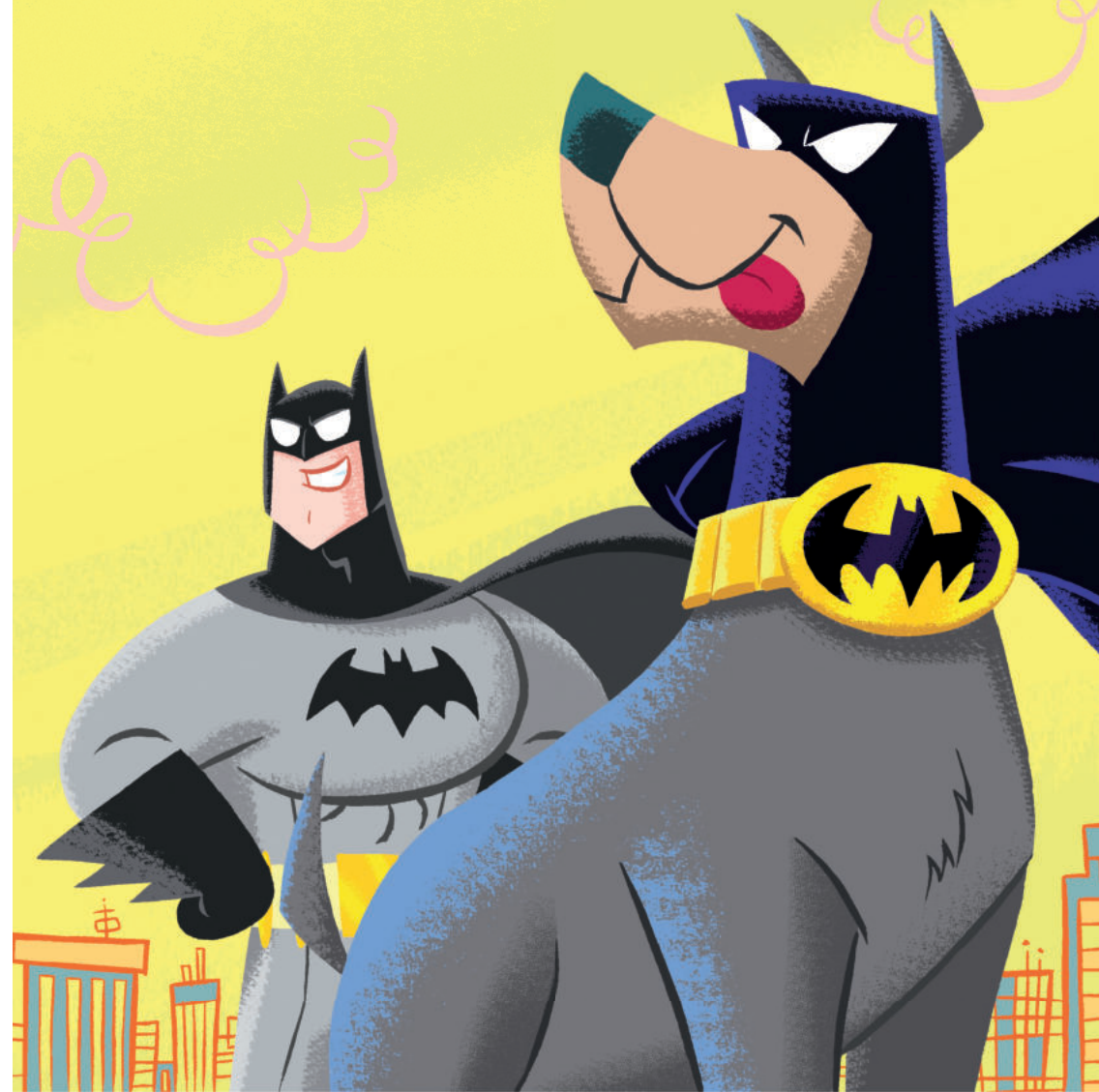
“We are delighted to have the Super Friends with us today,” the judge told the roaring crowd. “And their amazing Super-Pets!”
